Appendix 2: In-House Registry

RNs work hard.

We're committed to our patients and we go the extra mile.

Sometimes that "extra mile" means we agree to work an extra shift when needed, after we've already worked a full schedule.


Before our new contract went into effect, the hospital was sometimes calling RNs in to work additional shifts...but then later, if an RN was flexed off the following week, the hospital would retroactively reclassify those extra hours as regular time.

That is no longer permitted with our new contract language in Appendix 2—In-House Registry, Section C. 3. g., which states:

"If a reduction in scheduled hours is necessary due to low census or other hospital occurrences, those canceled hours will accrue toward In-House Registry status."

> I'm glad that the hospital agreed with our Bargaining Team that after putting in a full week, any RN committed enough to work extra hours in order to help out with patients should get the extra recognition.
